Notes

- For us to benefit from Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).

- You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see above).
- If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- The Inland Revenue requires that for us to benefit from Gift Aid, all payments made must be in a verifiable form i.e. Standing Order, Cheque, Credit Card, or be receipted.

We will not retain your information except as required by HM Revenue and Customs to process your Gift Aid application.
